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In the name of God , Amen, this fifth day of October, in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety five, I, John Bland, of the County of Nelson, of the State of Ky., being in a weak and low state of health, but of perfect mind and memory, and calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men to die, I do constitute, make and ordain this to be my last will and testament.

Principally and first, I freely give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it to me. My body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in a christianlike and decent manner, at the direction of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of God who gave it to me, and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me, in this life, I do give devise and dispose of in manner and form following viz:- Item first it is my will that Margaret, my dearly beloved wife for her support during her natural life, inherit all my estate both real and personal, moveable and immoveable, unless such moiety as in this shall be hereafter mentioned to be given to my other heirs of my said estate and after her death mention to be made how to divide the same equally agreeable to my will and pleasure.

Item second- It is my will that my eldest son, Osborne Bland, be paid twenty pounds cash out of my said estate, at the decease of my dearly beloved wife, Margaret.

Item Third:- It is my will that my eldest daughter, Prudence Smith, be paid five pounds specie in like manner as above in case any of her heirs should ever come after the same and if not, the same to be equally divided among my other heirs.

Item fourth:- It is my will that my son Samuel Bland be paid thirty pounds specie to be paid in like manner as above specified.

Item fifth:- It is my will that my son John Bland shall have a conveyance of a part of a tract of land I purchased of James Davis with Jesse Davis his surety, which conveyance I do allow my Executors to make to my said son, John, agreeable to a bond I now have on the said James and Jesse Davis said land to begin at a dogwood and sugar tree corner to John Jenkinson and coming with his line N 70 E 124 to a walnut and two red buds standing in Jenkinson's line thence S 10 E 78---- to one other line in said survey, thence with two other lines of said survey to the beginning.

Item sixth:- It is my will that my two sons Isaac and Elijah Bland shall have the remaining part of the land I now hold on the waters of Simpson's Creek, at the decease of my beloved wife, Margaret, Also one negro each of them is to have of the increase of my negro woman Susy, which it is my will that Isaac is to have the choice of the same, Isaac and Elijah are to pay forty pounds to the specie. Remaining of my estate is to be paid in one years after the decease of my wife Margaret.

Item seventh:- It is my will that the remaining part of my moveable estate together with my real estate is to be equally divided among six of my children

named, Mildred Hughes, Daniel Bland, William Bland, John Bland , Frances Hughes and Molly Randolph.

Item eighth:- It is my will that Nancy Bland daughter of Henry Bland, is to have twenty pounds specie, which is to come out of Mildred Hughes part of my estate.

*Who is this?*

Item ninth and lastly:- It is my will that my dearly beloved wife Margaret, together with Daniel and John Bland, my two sons, be my executors whom I constitute and appoint of this my last will and testament and I also do revoke and do annul all and every other will, or wills, legacy or legacies made by me. Ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and date first written.

James Bland married Mary Wyatt, Nelson Co., Oct. 22, 1818 moved to Warren Co., Missouri about 1825( See "History of Clinton Co., Mo." and "History of Warren Co., Mo." "History of Clay & Platte Co., Mo.", James Bland was born in Nelson Co., Ky. Feb. 23, 1793 and died Jan. 6, 1849, his wife Mary Wyatt died Dec. 20, 1877 while visiting her sons John Bland and H. A. Bland in Paris, Texas, she was buried Liberty, Clay Co., Mo., she was born May 28, 1799. News clipping of her death as follows: "Mrs Mary Bland, mother of Mrs. T.C. Gordon, of this County, died in Paris, Texas, about Dec. 20th, She had gone to Texas to visit her sons, John and H.A. Bland. She had long been a citizen of Clay County, who was beloved by all who enjoyed her acquaintance, and her death will be sincerely mourned. A good woman has gone to rest. The History of Clinton Co., Mo give information about Dr. William Wyatt Bland, which gives his birth Aug. 10, 1819 stating his father James Bland and mother Mary Wyatt was of Crab Orchard Ky. Dr. Bland received his medical education in St. Louis and then moved to Maryville, Mo in 1840. In 1850 he went to California for 3 years, returning to Clay Co., Mo for a time then to Clinton Co., In 1880 he was elected to the State Senate representing a district composed of Clay, Platte and Clinton Counties. In 1854 he married Annie E. Payne of Clinton Co. They are the parents of seven children
